#### VOTER REGISTRATION

##### WHEN IS THE LAST DAY TO REGISTER TO VOTE?

Arizona's voter registration deadline for the upcoming General Election is October 5.

#### FINANCIAL AID

If you register to vote in Arizona, or another state this could affect your financial aid. Before registering, contact a financial aid advisor to see whether your grants or scholarships will be impacted.

#### EARLY VOTING

##### CAN I GET A BALLOT IN THE MAIL?

If you want to request a ballot by mail, make sure your voter registration address is current. Check your information at [BeBallotReady.Vote](https://BeBallotReady.Vote). You can request a ballot by mail by October 23 if you registered to vote by October 5.

Remember to check your mail. Return your ballot by mail by October 27, or drop it off at any voting location or secure ballot drop box by 7 p.m. on November 3.

#### VOTING IN PERSON

##### WHAT DO I NEED TO VOTE IN PERSON?

Vote Centers are open October 7 – November 3, including some evenings and weekends. You can choose to vote at any location listed at [Locations.Maricopa.Vote](https://Locations.Maricopa.Vote).

Every voter is required to show proof of identity when voting in person. You need a valid government issued ID that includes your name, photo and the address where you are registered to vote (ex. AZ driver license, State ID or tribal ID). If that ID does not match your voter record, you need two forms of ID. Visit [GetID.Maricopa.Vote](https://GetID.Maricopa.Vote) for more information.

#### MOVING OR TRAVELING

##### HAVE YOU MOVED WITHIN THE COUNTY?

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, many students have moved off campus for the unforeseeable future. If you are a student who has moved recently, or is moving soon due to the pandemic, and you are still in Maricopa County, update your address either online or by mail.

First, verify your voter registration address at [BeBallotReady.Vote](https://BeBallotReady.Vote). Then, give us a call at (602) 506-1511 to request a ballot sent to a temporary address by 5 p.m. on October 23.

##### STUDYING ABROAD?

Check [MilitaryOverseas.Maricopa.Vote](https://MilitaryOverseas.Maricopa.Vote) to register and request your early ballot.

##### I DON'T LIVE IN ARIZONA ANYMORE. HOW CAN I VOTE?

Check with your local election office or the Office of the Secretary of State for voter registration requirements and deadlines.
